



School uniforms coming to FCSD!

Due to a major increase in dress code violations, the Fulton City School District today announced plans to implement school uniforms in the district's dress code next year.

The school district believes that the dress codes in the district have been violated too many times for change not to occur. Many teachers in the district are supporting this change in the dress code. One teacher, who wishes to remain anonymous believes that,

"this change will make our students college and career ready."

Beginning in September, all students within the Fulton City School District will be required to wear black dress pants or skirt (ankle length), along with a red and green plaid blazer. Students will also be required to wear a lanyard including a picture identification.

Each complete uniform will cost an average of \$100, but discounts will also be available to ensure that everyone meets the new code. If students do not adhere to the new dress code next year, they may be fined up to \$500 or even expelled.
